It's hard to say what caused the damage to his right hind leg, but most gangs in the city use baseball bats and pipes as their weapons of choice.

The vets are treating Chance's wounds even as I type this, at least the physical ones.

He needs to be stabilized before they can do surgery on his leg. The doctors are hopeful they can save it. But there is a possibility it will need to be amputated.

A warm bath will remove the blue spray paint that covers his body. But it will take much longer to heal his spirit.
